- PARTICIPATING TEAMS:** Boone Central/Newman Grove, Columbus Lakeview, Columbus Scotus, David City, Hartington/Newcastle, North Bend Central, O'Neill, Ord, Pierce, Wayne, West Point-Beemer
- DISTRICT ENTRIES:** Accessed on-line, they are due on October 3th. The NSAA and Boone Central/Newman Grove will your receive entries.
- AWARDS:** Fifteen medals will be awarded along with team championship and runner-up plaques. The awards will be presented on the back porch of the Albion Country Club.
- STATE QUALIFIERS:** The top 15 individuals and the top 3 teams will qualify for the state meet. (Kearney on Friday, October 21)
- EQUIPMENT NOTICE:** Competitors must have a regulation track uniform.
- Uniforms- Please check page 8 and 9 of the 2016 Cross Country Manual.
- Sect. 6 – Competitors Uniform
Art. 1, Art. 2, Art. 3*
- *Cross Country runners may wear headbands, but they must be unadorned (except for the permissible logo and/or school name) and be the following colors: beige, white, black or the predominant color of the jersey. All team members must wear the same color.*
- RESULTS:** The results will be tabulated and printed as soon as possible after races are completed. Runners will receive a card at the finish line, which should help facilitate scoring. Runners need to keep those cards. Fans, athletes, and others should stay away from the area that is roped off at the finish line.
- NOTE:** Please remind your kids to be courteous when using the Albion Country Club Course and Grounds. PLEASE REFRAIN FROM WALKING ON GREENS. Access to the building will not be permitted, however there will be portable restrooms on hand for use by spectators and competitors.
- SCORING:** Teams are allowed to run six competitors, while four are scored.
- Tie-breaking

Ties in Class C team scoring shall be resolved by comparing the fifth-place finishers from the tied teams.

*The team with the best fifth-place finisher shall prevail.

*If one team does not have a fifth-place finisher, the team with a fifth place finisher shall prevail.

*If only four competitors of the tied teams finish, the team scoring shall be resolved by totaling scores of the first three finishers.
