*Spiked shoes are permitted; however, it is recommended that spikes not be more than one-half inch in length.

*Any team or runner not ready to run at the appointed time shall forfeit his/her right to run unless an explanation satisfactory to the local manager can be presented.

Awards *Team plaques will be awarded to the teams placing first and second in each district meet.

*Individual medals will be presented to competitors placing first through fifteenth

*The top three teams in team scoring in each district will qualify for the State Championships in Kearney.
